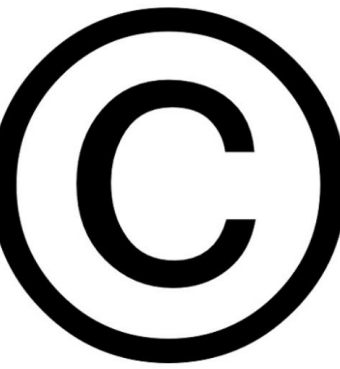




Did MK-Ultra transform storied American geographer William "Wild Bill" Bunge into a Defenestrator?

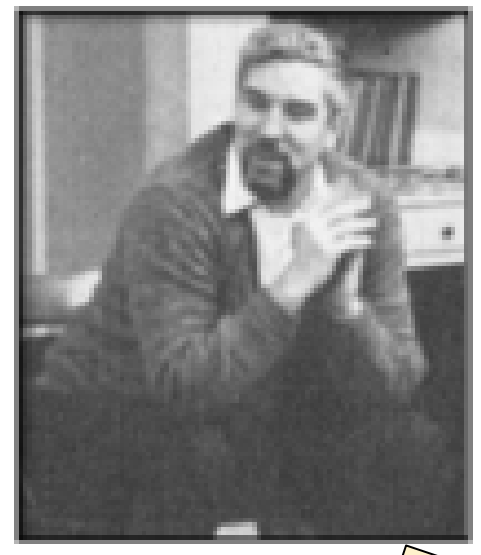

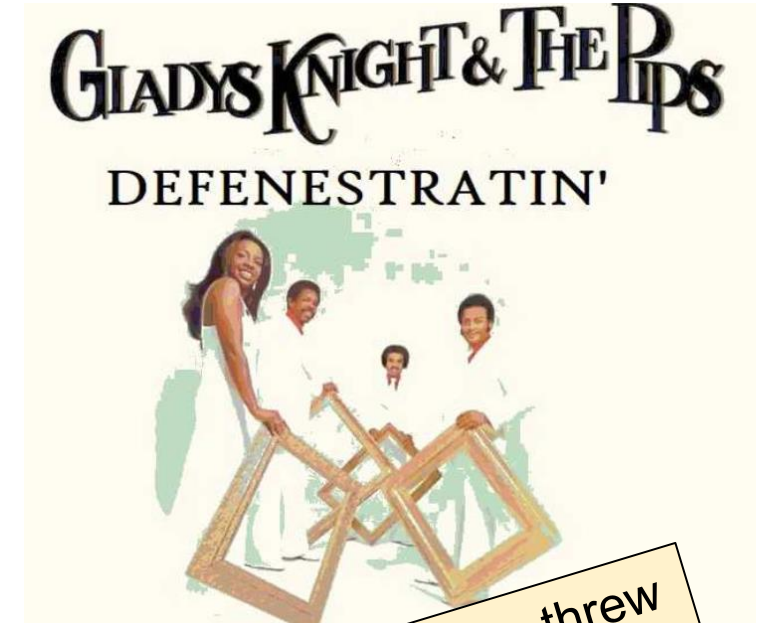


A persistent rumor suggests an act of defenestration occurred at Wayne State University in 1968. The incendiary and notorious American geographer 'Wild Bill' Bunge is said to have thrown an unruly student from a window.

Bunge (on the allegation that he threw a student out of a large window), claimed the charge was a 'canard', - Barnes, 2017

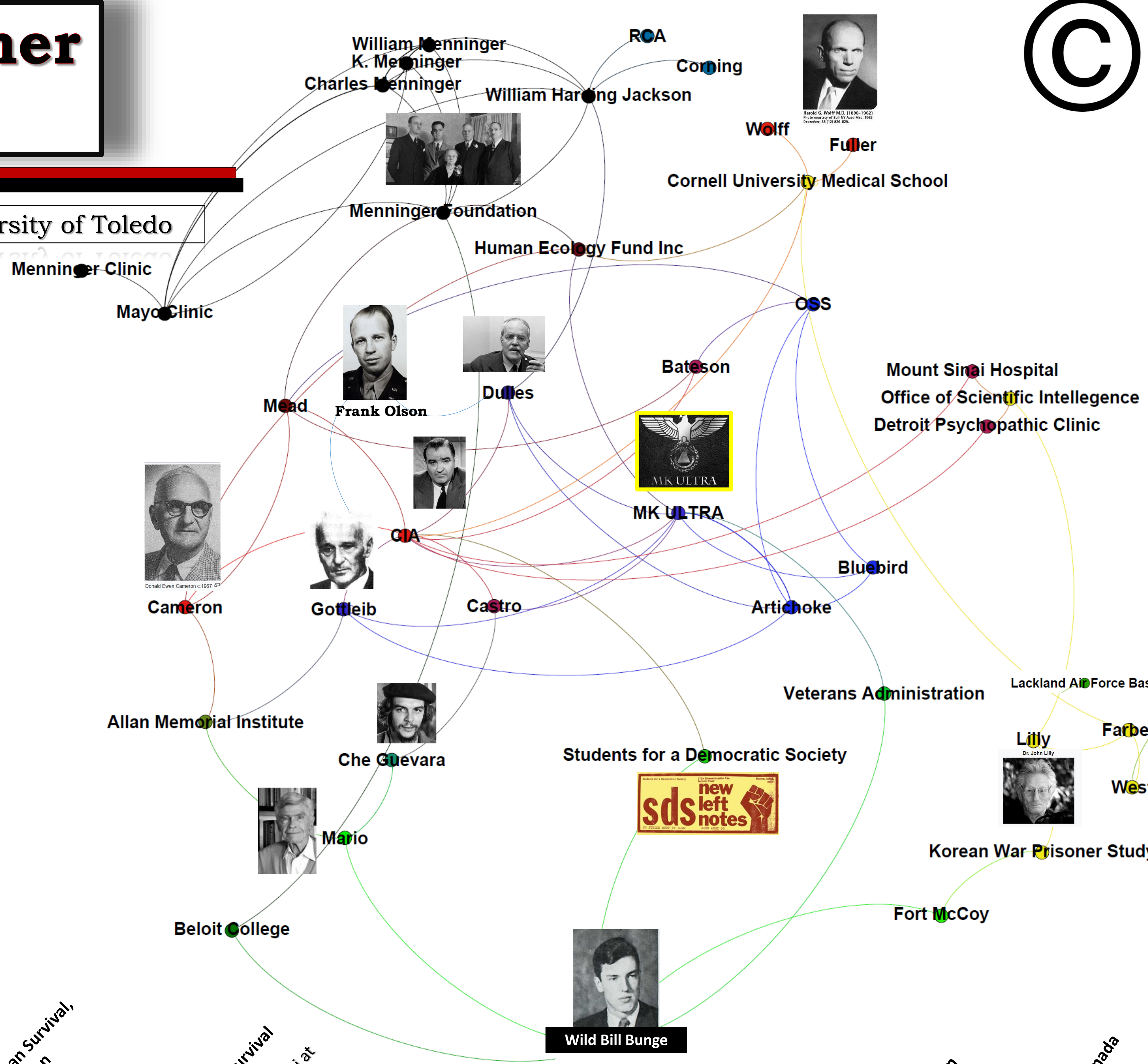
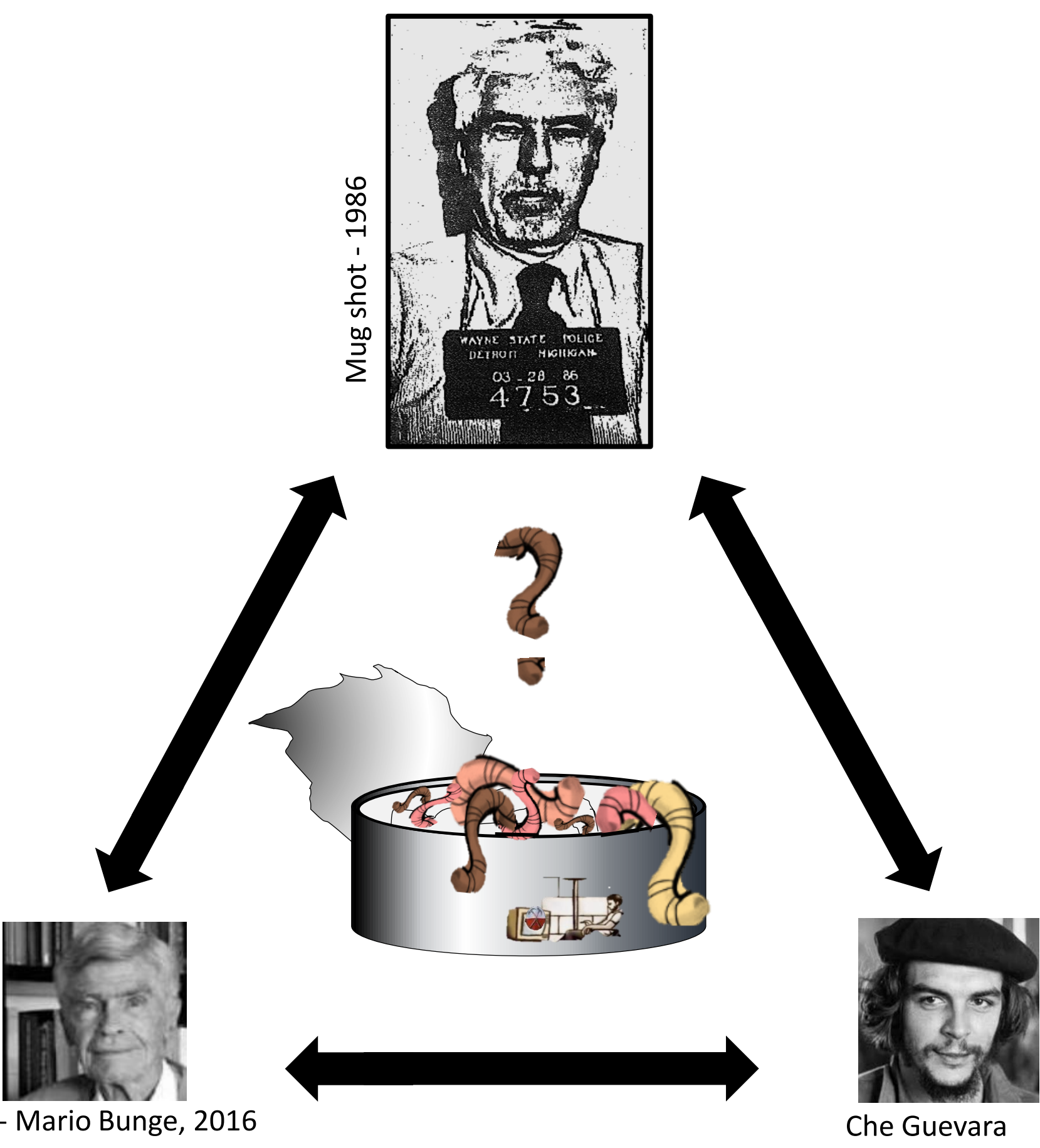
The Defenestrator; a Marvel Comic superhero member of Section 8 team who is known for throwing a cop through the same window 14 times.

Colleagues found him "too threatening and confrontational" (Wisner nd; Goodchild 2008)

We aim to evaluate the authoritative and disputed claims that he was:

1. A defenestrator (or was defenestrated by) a student while living in Fitzgerald;
2. An unwilling casualty of the CIS's nefarious MKUltra mind-control experiments;
3. Affiliated with SDS, the Black Panthers, and the Communist Party;
4. Shared a common ancestry with Ernesto "Che" Guevara;
5. toward the end of his life an enthusiastic recruiter of graduate students with the aim of organizing a final capstone "Geographical Expedition" in search of the secret burial site in Canada of the great Shawnee War Chief, Tecumseh

Finally, there was William Bunge, an American mathematical geographer who came to Montreal chased by Senator McCarthy's hounds. At my university's Allan Memorial Institute of Mental Health, William was an unwitting guinea pig in the infamous experiment, carried out by famous McGill professors funded by the CIA, designed to see whether it was possible to control minds by means of massive LSD doses. This brutal treatment left William handicapped for life, and he lived the rest of it on a mean pension in a distant and cold Quebec village. William is one of the millions of forgotten lives destroyed by the Cold War. He is also a reminder of the need to honor the Hippocratic oath, perhaps the earliest humanistic manifesto.
